### **Eligibility**

The Marymount Lacrosse Camps are open to boys entering grades 3-10.

### **Location**

Both the evening and day camps will be held on the main campus of Marymount University in Arlington, Virginia.

### **Insurance**

Campers must provide medical insurance. Both camps will have a certified athletic trainer on duty at all times.

### **Evening Camp**

The evening camp will run from 5:30 pm - 8:00 pm, Monday through Friday. Check-in will begin at 5:00 pm on Monday.

### **Day Camp**

The day camp will run from 9:00 am - 3:00 pm, Monday through Friday. Check-in will begin on Monday at 8:30 am. Lunch can be purchased in the dining hall everyday or handled prior to the beginning of camp.

### **Equipment Rental**

Rental Equipment is available for a \$35 charge per week.

### **What To Bring**

An information packet will be mailed to each camper after his application is processed. All equipment is required to play plus comfortable running shoes or cleats along with a water bottle.

Jon Reynolds is in his fifth season as the Head Coach for Marymount. The Saints continue to improve each year since his return. Competing against a nationally ranked schedule every year the team continues to post big wins and All-Conference selections every year. A local graduate of Thomas Edison H.S., Coach Reynolds was a defenseman for the Saints from 1996-00 helping the team post a top 20 National Ranking. Following his playing career, he was the Defensive Assistant coach for MU in 2000-01 before taking over the program at Yorktown H.S. from 2002-05. He led Yorktown to two District Championship Games, four Regional Playoff births, as well as posting 22 1st Team All District players, and 1 Player of the Year. He has 10 years of experience running instructional lacrosse camps. Each year coach Reynolds enlists some of the top College talent in the college game today. Past camp counselors have been from schools such as Ohio State, SUNY Cortland, Nazareth, Lynchburg, Salisbury, and of course Marymount.

## Marymount Facilities

Campers at the Marymount Lacrosse Camps will have access to the University's state-of-the-art Division III varsity athletic facilities.

### **Synthetic Turf Field**

Marymount University's Field-Turf practice facility will be used for all sessions. This is the same surface presently used by over half of all NFL teams a number of colleges.

### **Indoor Gymnasium**

A full-size, air conditioned indoor gymnasium will be available in the event of inclement or extremely hot weather.

### **Indoor Pool**

The day camp will feature daily use of the school's competition pool. Lifeguards will be on duty at all times.

### **Training & Rehabilitation Room**

Minor injuries will be treated in the school's varsity training room.

### **University Dining Hall**

Day campers will have the option of purchasing an all-you-can-eat lunch in the school dining facility for a \$6 daily charge. Prepayment for this is preferred.
